SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION

DECATUR ADVENTIST JUNIOR ACADEMY currently does not provide scholarships but offer supplementary assistance to parents seeking additional aid. Assistance is available through non-profit organizations such as AAA or Arete, their faith-based community, friends and family members to secure funding for tuition.

AAA and Arete Scholars Fund

AAA Scholarship Foundation (AAA) and Arete Scholars Fund are two separate private non-profit, 501(c)(3), approved Student Scholarship Organizations operating in the state of Georgia. Both programs award Private School Tax Credit Scholarships to eligible students entering Pre-K through High School to help them attend an eligible private school of their choice.

Currently, DAJA has students who are supported by both scholarships. Georgia law limits the amount of tax credits available for donations to organizations like AAA and Arete.

The Georgia Special Needs Scholarship Program GSNS

The Georgia Special Needs Scholarship Program, a school voucher program, was enacted and launched in 2007 to help students with special needs access schools that best fit their needs. Vouchers are worth up to the cost of the educational program a student would have received in public school, as calculated by existing state funding formulas. **It excludes only such things as capital costs and federal subsidy programs. The voucher may not exceed the private school's tuition and fees.**
